- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-19 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to definitions; to amend and reenact sections 15-19-01, 15-19-02,
- 3 15-19-02.1, 15-19-04, 15-19-06, and 15-19-08, and 15-20.1-03 of the North Dakota Century
- 4 Code, relating to distance education; and to repeal sections 15-19-03 and 15-19-04 of
- 5 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to authorization of enrollments to the center for
- 6 distance education by a superintendent of a school and advertising.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-19-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is

9 amended and reenacted as follows:

15-19-01. DistanceNorth Dakota center for distance education courses -

- 11 Establishment - Enrollment of students - Courses of instruction.
- 12 The state shall provide distance educationkindergarten through grade twelve courses.
- 13 comprehensive educational support, and high school diplomas through the center for distance
- 14 education under the following provisions:
- 15 A complete curriculum by distance education which has been specifically determined-1.
- 16 by prescribed by state-mandated education accreditation entities which meets the
- 17 requirements for digital education the superintendent of public instruction as proper-
- 18 and suitable for instruction under distance education methods, such determination and
- 19 approval to be made not less than once in each school year, must be maintained upon-
- 20 the campus of one of the state institutions of higher educationhas deemeddetermined
- 21 to be appropriate and proper.
- 22 2. Unless specifically excused in writing upon the course application forms by theA
- 23 superintendent or an administrator of thea school approving may deny the enrollment 24
 - application, orof a student in that district at the center for distance education except as

1		provided in subsection 5, all students under the age of sixteen taking advantage of the
2		provisions of this chapter must be required to attend their local district schools and to
3		study their distance education lessons under the supervision of a local supervisor. If
4		not required to attend their local schools, their work may be done at a place
5		designated by the state director. If in attendance at a local school, students must be
6		supplied with desk space in their respective school without charge and shall attend-
7		school regularly and be under the same disciplinary supervision of the teachers as the
8		other school students.
9	3.	The center for distance education may provide services to persons who are not North
10		Dakota residents.
11	4.	DistanceCenter for distance education students shall pay for books and materials
12		used by them, postage required to mail reports to the center, and other fees as may be
13		prescribed by the state director board for career and technical education.
14	5.	Students exempt from the compulsory school attendance laws pursuant to
15		subdivision e of subsection 1 of section 15.1-20-02 may enroll in distance education
16		courses offered through the center for distance education. These students may study
17		their center for distance education lessons in their learning environment under the
18		supervision of a parent. The tests for the distance education study must be
19		administered by an individual who is licensed to teach by the education standards and
20		practices board or approved to teach by the education standards and practices board
21		and employed either by the public school district in which the parent resides or a
22		state-approved private or nonpublic school.
23	SEC	TION 2. A new section to chapter 15-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
24	and ena	cted as follows:

26	In th	is chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:
27	1.	"Administration" includes the leadership of the center for distance education.
28	2.	"Board" means the state board for career and technical education.
29	<u>3.</u>	"Center" means the North Dakota center for distance education.
30	4.	"Director" means the director and executive officer of the department of career and
31		technical education.

1	SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 15-19-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
2	amended and reenacted as follows:		
3	15-19-02. Administration - Director of centerCenter for distance education -		
4	Appointment and duties.		
5	The program of and all activities related to the center for distance education are the		
6	responsibility of the center for distance education and under the supervision authority of the		
7	educational technology councilstate board for career and technical education. The educational-		
8	technology council shallexecutive director of the department of career and technical education		
9	mayshall hire a state director of administration and staff for the center for distance education		
10	who must be classified under the state personnel merit system. The directoradministration of		
11	the center shall carry out the director's administration's responsibilities in the administration		
12	ofadministering operating the center for distance education in the manner approved by the		
13	educational technology councilstate board for career and technical education, under the		
14	supervision of the executive-director of the department of career and technical education, and		
15	compliant with requirements established by the superintendent of public instruction and the		
16	education standards and practices board for public school administrators and teachers. The		
17	state board for career and technical education shall administer the responsibilities of the board		
18	of a school district relating to the center for distance education.		
19	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 15-19-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
20	amended and reenacted as follows:		
21	15-19-02.1. Distance education clearinghouse.		
22	The director of the administration of the center for distance education shall establish a		
23	clearinghouse for online courses delivered to North Dakota schools for the purpose of providing:		
24	1. A list of the online courses and providers for all North Dakota schools to access.		
25	2. Awareness of online courses available in new and emerging careers.		
26	3. A list of comparative prices for online courses and other online services.		
27	4. Awareness of the differences between technological innovation and learning		
28	innovation.		
29	SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 15-19-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is		

30 amended and reenacted as follows:

3	the superintendent shall ensure that the courses offered by the center for distance education-		
4	meet state content standards and shall monitor compliance with sections 15.1-18-02 and		
5	15.1-18-03. The center for distance education may advertise its distance education		
6	program	i programs .	
7	SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 15-19-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
8	amended and reenacted as follows:		
9	15-19-06. Special funds - Deposit of collections - Transfers from general fund		
10	approp	riations.	
11	1.	A special operating fund for the center for distance education must be maintained	
12		within the state treasury and all income and fees collected by the center for distance	
13		education from any source must be remitted monthly by the director to the state	
14		treasurer and credited to the special operating fund. All expenditures from the fund	
15		must be within the limits of legislative appropriations and must be made upon	
16	1	vouchers, signed and approved by the technology director appointed by the	
17		educational technology councilexecutive director for the department of career and	
18		technical education. Upon approval of the vouchers by the office of the budget,	
19		warrant-checks must be prepared by the office of management and budget. The state-	
20		treasurer shall make periodic transfers upon order of the director of the office of	
21		management and budget from the center for distance education general fund-	
22		appropriation to the special operating fund whenever its balance falls so low as to	
23		require supplementation.	
24	2.	The educational technology council may establish an administrative operational fund,	
25		of not to exceed ten thousand dollars, out of the special operating fund for the center-	
26		for distance education. The administrative operational fund must be deposited in the	
27		Bank of North Dakota and may be drawn upon by the state director of the center for-	
28		distance education for the payment of necessary expenses in the administration and	
29		operation of the center for distance education within the limits and rules prescribed by	
30		the educational technology council. The director shall submit a full, minute, and	
31		itemized statement of every expenditure made during the month to the council in-	

1		accordance with the rules adopted by the council, and thereafter the council may
2		periodically authorize additional transfers to the administrative operational fund, but
3		the balance in the fund may never exceed ten thousand dollars, and any
4		unencumbered balance at the end of any biennium must revert to the state treasury.
5		The administrative operational fund may not be used to pay salaries or expenses of
6		the director.
7	3.	The educational technology councilstate board for career and technical education may
8		establish aan endowment and scholarship fund to provide financial grants to students
9		enrolled in courses offered through the center for distance education. The endowment
10		and scholarship fund may consist only of those funds specifically appropriated by the
11		legislative assembly and property received by the council or the center for distance
12		education as a gift, devise, or bequest. Any gift, devise, or bequest of property
13		received by the council or center for distance education which is designated by the
14		councilstate board for career and technical education and donor for the endowment
15		and scholarship fund must be deposited in the scholarship fund at the Bank of North
16		Dakota. The state director of the center for distance education may draw only on the-
17		interest earned by the scholarship fund for the award of scholarships within the limits-
18		and rules adopted by the educational technology councilstate board for career and
19		technical education. The interest earned by the scholarship fund is appropriated to the

center for distance education. The center for distance education may draw on the
 endowment and scholarship fund for the award of endowments and scholarships
 within the limits and rules adopted by the state board for career and technical

education.

SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 15-19-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

26 **15-19-08. Distance education** work<u>support and services</u>.

The amount of money appropriated by the legislative assembly for distance education
worksupport and services for a biennium, or so much thereof as may be necessary, must be
expended first for work provided by distance education as determined by the center for distance
education and approved by the state board for career and technical education.

5	The state board shall have all authority necessary to cooperate with the United States				
6	department of education or other department or agency of the United States of America in the				
7	administration of acts of Congress relating to career and technical education, including the				
8	following powers and duties:				
9	1.	1. To administer any legislation enacted by the legislative assembly of this state pursuant			
10		to or	in conformity with acts of Congress relating to career and technical education.		
11	2.	. To administer the funds provided by the federal government and by this state for the			
12		prom	notion of career and technical education and to contract with:		
13		a.	Any public or private institution or agency, board of trustees of any agricultural		
14			and training school, or school district of this state; or		
15		b.	Any public or private institution or agency, or political subdivision, of another		
16			state.		
17	3.	To fo	ormulate plans for the promotion of career and technical education in such		
18		subje	ects as are an essential and integral part of the public school system of education		
19		in thi	is state.		
20	4.	То р	rovide for the preparation of teachers.		
21	5.	To fix	x the compensation of such officers and assistants as may be necessary to		
22		adm	inister the federal acts and the provisions of this chapter relating to career and		
23		tech	nical education and to pay the same and other necessary expenses of		
24		adm	inistration from any funds appropriated for such purpose.		
25	6.	To m	nake studies and investigations relating to career and technical education.		
26	7.	То р	romote and aid in the establishment of schools, departments, or classes, and to		
27		coop	perate with local communities in the maintenance of career and technical		
28		educ	cation schools, departments, or classes.		
29	8. To prescribe the qualifications and provide for the certification of teachers, directors,				
30		and	supervisors.		

1	9.	To cooperate with governing bodies of school districts and with organizations and	
2		communities in the maintenance of classes for the preparation of teachers, directors,	
3		and supervisors of career and technical education, to maintain classes for such	
4		purposes under its own direction and control, and to establish and control, by general	
5		regulations, the qualifications to be possessed by persons engaged in the training of	
6		career and technical education teachers.	
7	10.	To coordinate new and existing farm management programs offered by any state	
8		agency or entity.	
9	11.	To create and expand marketing clubs as adjuncts to new and existing farm	
10		management programs.	
11	12.	To administer and supervise the program and all activities of the center for distance	
12		education.	
13	SEC	CTION 8. REPEAL. SectionSections 15-19-03 and 15-19-04 of the North Dakota	
14	Century Code isare repealed.
