- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 43-32-19.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to regulation of applied behavioral analysts.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 4 of section 43-32-19.1 of the North Dakota 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 4. The board may grant a provisional license or registration to an expedited licensure applicant while the application is pending.
 - a. The board mayshall grant a provisional an expedited license or registration to an individual who is applying for licensure or registration as an applied behavior analyst if the individual is certified by a professional organization that is identified by the board by rule the behavior analyst certification board. The certification is deemed to meet any education, experience, and examination requirements for licensure or registration as an applied behavior analyst.
 - b. The board may deny or place restrictions on a provisional or expedited license or registration under this subsection if in another jurisdiction, within the previous five years, the applicant had a disciplinary action against the applicant's license or registration.
