PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1524

Page 1, line 1, after "A BILL" replace the remainder of the bill with "for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of privacy practices in the data broker industry.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - DATA BROKER

INDUSTRY. During the 2019-20 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying privacy practices in the data broker industry to determine whether adequate safety measures exist to prevent fraud and protect the identifying information of consumers. The study must include consultation with the department of commerce and the attorney general, and an evaluation of the nature and sources of the consumer information the data brokers collect, how data brokers use, maintain, and disseminate the information, and the extent to which the data brokers allow consumers to access and correct their information or to opt out of having their personal information sold. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-seventh legislative assembly."
