- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 37-17.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the process of expending funds from the disaster relief fund.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 37-17.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 37-17.1-27. State disaster relief fund Creation Uses.
 - There is created in the state treasury a state disaster relief fund. Moneys in the fund are to be used subject to legislative appropriations and emergency commission and budget section approval for providing the required state share of funding for expenses and administration associated with presidential declared disasters in the statefederal emergency management agency disaster response, recovery, and mitigation grants, and for the purposes of reimbursing costs under section 37-17.1-28. Agencies appropriated funding from the state disaster relief fund shall provide the budget section with quarterly reports detailing expenditures made from the appropriation. Any interest or other fund earnings must be deposited in the fund. Before any expenditure is made from the fund, the agency authorized to make the expenditure shall provide information on the purpose and payee of the expenditure to the appropriations committees of the house of representatives and senate or, if the legislative assembly is not in
