- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to back to school scholarships; and to provide an appropriation.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Back to school scholarship.
- The state board of higher education shall adopt policies and procedures to develop.
   implement, promote, and administer a back to school scholarship program to
   encourage residents of the state age twenty-six years or older to enroll in an institution
- 10 <u>under the control of the state board of higher education.</u>
- 11 <u>2.</u> <u>Individuals aged twenty-six years or older enrolled in an institution under the control of </u>

the state board of higher education may apply for a scholarship under this section.

- Eligible applicants may not have completed a course at an institution of higher
- 14 <u>education in the twelve months preceding the application nor previously received a</u>
- 15 <u>postsecondary degree.</u>

- 16 3. Subject to legislative appropriations, eligible applicants may be awarded up to one
- thousand dollars to assist the individual with the costs of completing the qualifying
- 18 <u>educational program. Scholarships are limited to the amount charged each quarter.</u>
- semester, or term by the educational institution for the tuition, fees, books, and
- 20 <u>supplies required for the educational program.</u>
- 21 <u>4. Each quarter, semester, or term, the state board of higher education shall distribute</u>
- 22 grants to institutions under the control of the state board of higher education to provide
- 23 the amounts necessary for the scholarships awarded to the students enrolled in each
- 24 institution.

## 1 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION - BACK TO

- 2 SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the
- 3 state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,000,000, or so much of the sum as
- 4 may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of providing financial
- 5 assistance to students eligible for the back to school scholarship program, for the biennium
- 6 beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.
