### **ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1183**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new sections to chapter 23-35 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to requiring public health units to adopt the technical guide for onsite
- 3 wastewater recycling treatment and establishing the onsite wastewater recycling technical
- 4 committee; and to provide for application an expiration date.

### 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 23-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
7 and enacted as follows:

#### 8 Public health units to adopt onsite wastewater recycling treatment guide.

9 Each public health unit shall adopt the statewide technical guide for onsite wastewater

10 recycling treatment technologies and sewage distribution technologies established by the onsite

- 11 <u>wastewater recycling technical committee.</u>
- SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 23-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
   and enacted as follows:

14 Onsite wastewater recycling technical committee - Appointment - Duties.

- 15 <u>1.</u> <u>The onsite wastewater recycling technical committee consists of:</u>
- 16a.ThreeFour representatives of a from local public health units appointed by the17governor from a list of names forwarded by local public health units; and
- 18 <u>b.</u> Four individuals who must be installers appointed by the governor. The governor
- 19 <u>shall appoint the individuals from a list of names forwarded by a professional</u>
- 20 <u>onsite wastewater recycling association. For purposes of this section, an installer</u>
- 21 <u>means an individual licensed by a local public health unit to install onsite</u>

22 <u>wastewater sewage treatment systems.</u>

23 2. The director of the department of environmental quality or the director's designee shall
 24 provide input at the request of the committee.

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1	<u>3.</u> <del>Th</del>	e terms of the committee members are for four years, and members may be
2	reappointed.	
3	<u>4.</u> <u>The committee shall:</u>	
4	<u>a.</u>	Meet at the call of a majority of the members.
5	<u>b.</u>	Create a statewide technical guide for onsite wastewater recycling treatment
6		technologies and sewage distribution technologies.
7	<u>C.</u>	Recommend standards and procedures for issuing an installer license.
8	<u>d.</u>	Recommend continuing education requirements for installer license renewal.
9	<u>e.</u>	Recommend reasonable fees for issuing or renewing an installer license.
10	- SECTION 3. APPLICATION. The governor shall appoint individuals to fill the committee-	
11	positions in accordance with this Act, and the terms of those appointees must be staggered so-	
12	not more than two positions expire in any year. To accomplish the staggering, the initial term of	
13	those appointees may be for less than four years.	
14	SECTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through July 31, 2023, and after that	
15	date is ineffective.
