- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the
- 2 secretary of state and public printing; to amend and reenact section 54-09-05 of the North
- 3 Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary of the secretary of state; and to provide an
- 4 exemption.

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## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the secretary of state for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 10 secretary of state and public printing, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023, as follows:

18	\$3,050,000 general fund appropriation for a technology project in the operating expenses line					
19	item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 36 of the 2015 Session Laws and continued into the					
20	2017-19 and 2019-21 bienniums are not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11. Any

23	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is					
24	amended and reenacted as follows:					
25	54-09-05. Salary of secretary of state.					
26	The annual salary of the secretary of state is one hundred seventwelve thousand eighttwo					
27	hundred eighty-fiveforty-one dollars through June 30, 20202021, and one hundred tenthirteen					
28	thousand fivenine hundred eighty-twotwenty-five dollars thereafter.					
29	SECTION 5. TRIBAL GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS. Of the funds					
30	appropriated in the grants line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, \$25,000 is from the

- 1 general fund for the purpose of providing grants to each federally recognized tribal government
- 2 located within the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023. The
- 3 secretary of state may provide grants in an amount up to \$5,000 to each tribal government to
- 4 reimburse administrative costs incurred by each tribal government to issue addresses and
- 5 identifications for voting purposes.
