- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 51-08.1-08 and section
- 2 51-15-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to damages, injunctive relief, and limitation
- 3 of actions; to amend and reenact section 51-08.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating
- 4 to civil penalty and injunctive enforcement; and to provide a penalty.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 51-08.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 51-08.1-07. Civil penalty and injunctive enforcement by state.
- The attorney general, or a state's attorney with the permission or at the request of the
- attorney general, may bring an action for appropriate injunctive relief, equitable relief, including
- 11 <u>disgorgement</u>, and civil penalties in the name of the state for a violation of this chapter. The trier
- of fact may assess for the benefit of the state a civil penalty of not more than fiftyone hundred
- thousand dollars for each violation of this chapter.
- **SECTION 2.** A new subsection to section 51-08.1-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 15 created and enacted as follows:
- The attorney general may bring an action as parens patriae on behalf of a person
- residing in the state to recover damages sustained by the person by reason of any
- 18 <u>violation of this chapter.</u>
- 19 **SECTION 3.** Section 51-15-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as
- 20 follows:

- 21 <u>51-15-12</u>. Limitation of actions.
- Notwithstanding chapter 28-01, an action for relief under this chapter is barred if the claim is
- 23 not commenced within four years after the claim for relief accrues. The period of limitation for a

- 1 <u>claim for relief may not be deemed to have accrued until the aggrieved party discovers the facts</u>
- 2 constituting the violation of this chapter.
