- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 12-60-16.12 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the unauthorized dissemination of criminal history record information; and to provide
- 3 a penalty.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 12-60-16.12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 <u>12-60-16.12. Criminal history record information Civil action Penalty.</u>
- 8 <u>1. A person that disseminates, publishes, or maintains or causes to be disseminated,</u>
- 9 <u>published, or maintained, the criminal history record information of an individual which</u>
- pertains to that individual's charge or arrest for a criminal offense, and solicits,
- 11 requests, or accepts money or other thing of value for removing the criminal history
- record information is civilly liable to that individual in the amount of five hundred dollars
- or actual damages, whichever is greater, plus reasonable attorney's fees and court
- 14 <u>costs.</u>
- 15 <u>2. Subsection 1 does not apply to:</u>
- 16 <u>a.</u> A constitutionally protected activity;
- b. An interactive computer service, as defined in 47 U.S.C. 230, for content
- 18 <u>provided by another person; or</u>
- 19 <u>c.</u> <u>The bureau, a criminal justice agency, or a person acting in accordance with the </u>
- authority provided under sections 12-60-16.1 through 12-60-16.11.
