- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 12-60-16.12 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the unauthorized dissemination of criminal history record information; and to provide
- 3 a penalty.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 12-60-16.12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 <u>12-60-16.12. Criminal history record information Civil action Penalty.</u>
- 8 <u>1. A person that disseminates, publishes, or maintains or causes to be disseminated,</u>
- 9 published, or maintained, the criminal history record information of an individual which pertains
- 10 to that individual's charge or arrest for a criminal offense, and solicits, requests, or accepts
- 11 money or other thing of value for removing the criminal history record information is civilly liable
- 12 <u>to that individual in the amount of five hundred dollars or actual damages, whichever is greater,</u>
- 13 plus reasonable attorney's fees and court costs.
- 14 <u>2. Subsection 1 does not apply to:</u>
- 15 <u>a. A constitutionally protected activity;</u>
- 16 <u>b. An interactive computer service, as defined in 47 U.S.C. 230, for content</u>
- 17 provided by another person; or
- 18 <u>c. The bureau, a criminal justice agency, or a person acting in accordance with the</u>

 19 <u>authority provided under sections 12-60-16.1 through 12-60-16.11.</u>
