- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 62.1-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the limitation on enforcing or providing assistance regarding violations
- 3 of federal firearm laws; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 62.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7 Federal firearms laws - Limitations on enforcement.

- 8 <u>1.</u> As used in this section, "firearm accessory" means an item used in conjunction with or
 9 mounted on a firearm but is not essential to the basic function of a firearm. The term
 10 includes a detachable firearm magazine.
- 11 <u>2.</u> <u>An agency or political subdivision of the state and a law enforcement officer or</u>
- 12 individual employed by an agency or political subdivision of the state may not provide
- 13 assistance to a federal agency or official or act independently with respect to the
- 14 investigation, prosecution, or enforcement of a violation of a federal statute, order,
- 15 <u>rule, or regulation purporting to regulate a firearm, firearm accessory, or firearm</u>
- 16 <u>ammunition unless:</u>
- 17 a. <u>The federal agency appeals to the federal district court of the federal district in</u>
 18 <u>which the violation or possible violation occurred or would occur and the court</u>
 19 <u>finds probably cause that a national security threat exists;</u>
- 20 <u>b.</u> <u>The violation also is a violation under this title; or</u>
- 21 <u>c.</u> <u>The violation also is a violation of chapter 12.1-17.</u>
- 3. This section does not prohibit an agency or political subdivision of the state or a law
 enforcement officer or individual employed by an agency or political subdivision of the

- 1 state from providing assistance to a federal agency or official for an offense not related
- 2 <u>to firearms.</u>
- 3 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
