- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 23-07 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to immunization exemptions.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 23-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Immunization Exception.
- Notwithstanding any other law, an individual who is required to receive an
 immunization for any purpose, including as a condition of employment, school
 attendance, or licensure, may claim an exemption from the immunization requirement
 if there is not a vaccine approved by the United States food and drug administration
- 11 <u>which meets the following criteria:</u>
- 12 <u>a. The pivotal clinical trial the United States food and drug administration relied</u>
 13 <u>upon to approve the vaccine evaluated the safety of the vaccine for at least one</u>
 14 <u>year after the vaccine was administered against a control group that received</u>
 15 <u>either a placebo or another vaccine that meets this criteria.</u>
 - b. The state department of health posts on the department's website the injuries or diseases caused by the vaccine and the rate at which the injury or disease
- 18 <u>occurs from the vaccine.</u>

- 19 c. The risk of permanent disability or death from the vaccine has been proven to be
 20 less than that caused by the infection the vaccine is intended to prevent.
- d. The vaccine's manufacturer has liability, including for design defect claims, for
 any death or injury caused by the vaccine.
 - 2. An individual may claim the exemption in subsection 1 on the individual's own behalf or on behalf of the individual's child or dependent. The state department of health or

- 1 any other state agency, board, or commission may not require the individual to meet
- 2 <u>any other condition or requirement to claim the exemption.</u>
