

**Sixty-seventh Legislative Assembly of North Dakota
In Regular Session Commencing Tuesday, January 5, 2021**

HOUSE BILL NO. 1378
(Representative Marschall)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 54-03-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to authority for the legislative assembly to conduct business in December of even-numbered years.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 54-03-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

1. The legislative assembly shall meet at the seat of government in the month of December following the election of the members thereof of the legislative assembly for organizational and orientation purposes and shall thereafter then may recess until the time provided in subsection 2. The legislative assembly also may convene in December following the election of the members of the legislative assembly to consider and vote on bills and resolutions and conduct any other business the legislative assembly is authorized to conduct during a regular session.
