- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 23-09-16.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to food and lodging establishment license renewals; and to amend and reenact sections
- 3 23-09-16 and 23-09-18 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to food and lodging
- 4 establishment licenses.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 23-09-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **23-09-16.** License Application.
- 9 Before any food establishment, lodging establishment, pushcart, mobile food unit, or
- assisted living facility may be operated in this state, it must be licensed by the department. The
- 11 department shall waive the license requirement for any food establishment, lodging
- 12 establishment, or assisted living facility licensed by a city or district health unit if the local health
- 13 unit's sanitation, safety, and inspection rules are approved by the department. Application for
- 14 license must be made to the department during December of every year, or before the
- 15 operating of the food establishment, lodging establishment, pushcart, mobile food unit, or
- 16 assisted living facility, as the case may be. The application must be in writing on forms furnished
- 17 by the department and must be accompanied by the required fee. An additional amount of fifty-
- 18 percent of the license fee must be imposed upon renewal if the license was not renewed before
- 19 February first following the expiration date. A reduced license fee in the amount of one-half the
- 20 applicable license fee must be charged for a new food establishment, lodging establishment,
- 21 pushcart, mobile food unit, or assisted living facility beginning operations after July first of each
- 22 year and for changes in ownership and location of such existing establishments after July first of
- 23 each year The department shall issue a license to an applicant that meets all of the
- 24 <u>requirements of this chapter and any rules established by the department.</u> The department may

- 1 adopt rules establishing the amount and the procedures for the collection of annual license
- 2 fees. The fees must be based on the cost of reviewing construction plans, conducting routine
- 3 and complaint inspections, <u>reinspection</u>, and necessary enforcement action. License fees
- 4 collected pursuant to this section must be deposited in the department's operating fund in the
- 5 state treasury and any expenditure from the fund is subject to appropriation by the legislative
- 6 assembly.

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- SECTION 2. Section 23-09-16.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enactedas follows:
- 9 **23-09-16.1. License renewal.**
 - 1. A license issued under this chapter expires on December thirty-first of each year.
- 11 <u>2. A license may be renewed by December thirty-first by submitting a renewal application</u>
- and a renewal fee established by the department by rule, provided the licensee is in
- compliance with this chapter and any rules established by the department.
- 14 <u>3. If the renewal application and renewal fee are not received by December thirty-first,</u>
- the license expires and the licensee may not operate.
- 16 <u>4.</u> Within sixty days after December thirty-first, an expired license may be renewed by
- submitting the renewal application, renewal fee, and a late fee established by the
- department by rule. The late fee is equal to fifty-percent of the license fee.
- 19 <u>5.</u> <u>If the renewal application, renewal fee, and late fee are not received within sixty days</u>
- 20 <u>after December thirty-first, the license may not be renewed, and the applicant shall</u>
- 21 apply and meet the requirements for licensure to be granted a license.
- 22 <u>6. The department may extend the renewal deadlines for an application providing proof</u>
- of hardship rendering the applicant unable to meet the deadline.
- **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 23-09-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 25 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 26 **23-09-18.** Failure to comply with chapter Notice How served.
- Whenever the proprietor of any food establishment, lodging establishment, or assisted living-
- 28 facility fails to comply with this chapter, the proprietor must be given notice of the time within-
- 29 which the proprietor must meet the requirements The department may deny an application or
- 30 take disciplinary action against the license of an applicant or a licensee upon the failure of the
- 31 applicant or licensee to comply with this chapter or with any of the rules adopted by the

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- 1 <u>department</u>. Before the department takes disciplinary action against a license for failure of a
- 2 <u>license</u>, the department shall notify the licensee in writing of the reason disciplinary action is
- 3 <u>being considered and shall provide a reasonable amount of time for correction to be made</u>. The
- 4 notice must be in writing and delivered personally by an inspector of the department or sent by
- 5 registered or certified mail. Action taken under the authority granted in this section must comply
- 6 with chapter 28-32.
