2 A. **Bill and fiscal impact summary:** Provide a brief summary of the measure, including description of the provisions having fiscal impact (limited to 300 characters).

HB1288 would require the Department's Medicaid program, including Medicaid Expansion, to cover costs of a continuous glucose monitoring device for an individual with diabetes. Costs are estimated at \$1,777,470 for 2021-2023 biennium.

Section 1 of HB1288 would require that the Department provide coverage for continuous glucose monitoring devices under the Departments Medicaid program including Medicaid Expansion. Expenditures are estimated to be \$1,777,470, of which \$479,585 is general fund, for the 2021-2023 biennium.

The Department currently has 1,683 recipients receiving blood glucose test strips and for the purpose of this fiscal note it was assumed only 40% of recipients would switch to continuous glucose monitoring during the first year and 60% of all recipients for the second year.

The Department would be able to draw down matching federal dollars from The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

For the 2021-2023 biennium, the Department of Human Services would need an appropriation increase in the Medical Grants line of \$1,777,470, of which \$479,585 would be General Fund, to HB1012.

For the 2023-2025 biennium, the Department of Human Services would need an appropriation in the Medical Grants line of \$2,133,382, of which \$575,696 would be General Fund.

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
