HB 1225 would eliminate the transition maximum from the school district foundation aid formula.

Section 1 eliminates the transition maximum from the school district foundation aid formula. School districts that receive a per pupil payment rate less than per pupil rate set in NDCC 15.1-27-04.1 would have their foundation aid payment calculated at the per pupil rate going forward.
