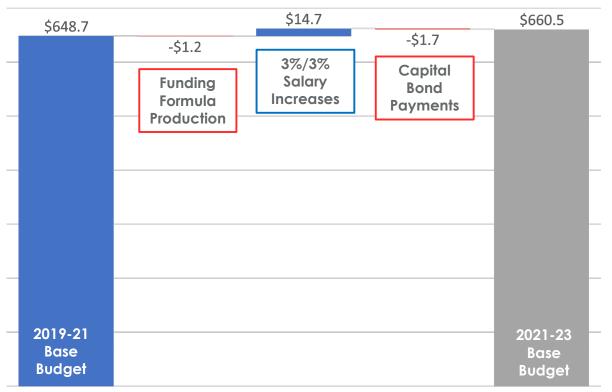

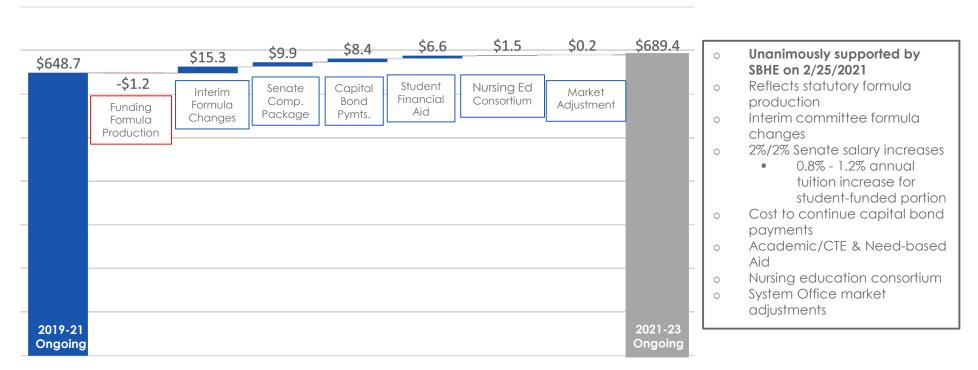

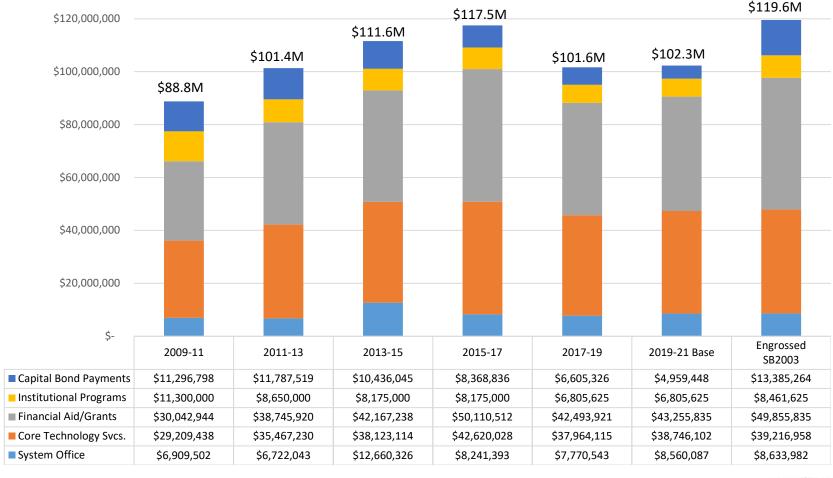

2021-23 Investment Opportunities

- Original request unanimously approved by SBHE on 6/27/2020
 - Improve student affordability
 - Strengthen institution programmatic flexibility
 - Shore up student financial aid programs
 - Improve System Governance funding
 - Increase efficiencies for student financial aid programs
- SBHE unanimously endorsed Senate version 2/25/2021



Systemwide Initiatives

- Student Share of Salary Increases-\$14.2 million
 - Eliminate need for 1.1% to 2.0% tuition increase
 - Improve student affordability
 - <u>Senate Version:</u> student share is \$9.7 million & tuition increase is 0.8% to 1.2%.
- Funding Formula Rate Increase- \$13.2 million
 - Programmatic funding for behavioral &mental health, increased student services, workforce initiatives, new program start up, Title IX implementation, & other institutional needs
- Nursing Education Consortium- \$1,356,000
 - Administration moves to System Office from UND
 - Continue current distribution methodology
- Math Pathways- \$150,000
 - Develop rigorous and robust courses in the areas of statistics and quantitative reasoning to better align math coursework with field of study & career goals



Student Financial Aid

- ND Academic & CTE Scholarship- \$4.2 million
 - Requested 2019, but not approved
 - # eligible student continue to increase
 - Line item transfer this biennium to pay students
- ND State Grant Program \$2.4 million
 - Maintain 6,200 need-based grants per year
- Financial Aid Systems-\$300,000
 - Antiquated systems risk failure
 - Streamline processes & administrative effort

System Governance

- Compensation adjustments to 80% market \$672,000
 - Long-term target is all experienced employees at 100% market
 - Interim goal is 80% market
 - Currently 18 at < 80%
 - Senate Version: Move to 70-75% of market
- Eliminate Campus Assessment for Internal Audit & Compliance functions - \$325,000
 - Now charged back to institutions

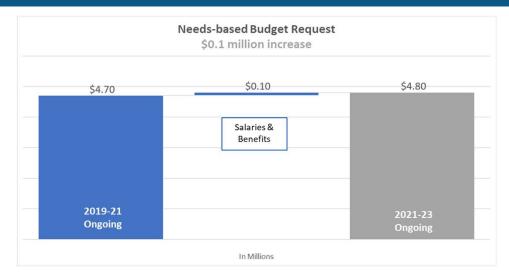

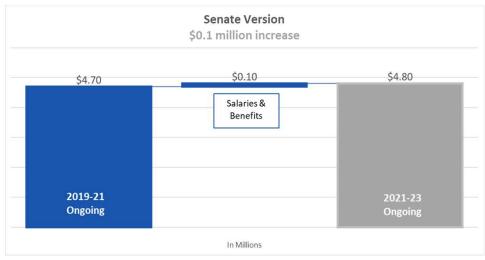
