VCSU land purchase	Section 4 provides authority and an appropriation of \$309,000 from other funds for VCSU to purchase two parcels of land in Barnes County from the VCSU Foundation.	
Additional funds appropriation authority	Section 5 appropriates any additional other funds received by entities under the control of the State Board of Higher Education to the respective entities.	
UND School of Medicine and Health Sciences funding	Section 6 authorizes the transfer of funds between UND and the UND School of Medicine and Health Sciences based on the recommendation of the Commissioner of Higher Education.	
Capital building fund program	Sections 7, 8, 9, and 16 continue the capital building fund program, including a \$19 million transfer from the strategic investment and improvements fund to the University System capital building fund, the carryover of unexpended funds appropriated for the 2019-21 biennium, the authorization of certain capital projects to use funding from the capital building fund, and the establishment of the program in North Dakota Century Code.

UND Technology Accelerator building refinancing	Section 21 provides authority for UND to refinance the bank loan for the Technology Accelerator building.
Transfer authority	Section 22 provides that the State Board of Higher Education may transfer funds from an institution's operations line item to the institution's capital assets line item if the board determines that additional funds are needed for capital assets.
