Chairman Monson and members of the House Appropriations Committee – Education and Environment Division:

My name is Randy Hatzenbuhler, President of the Theodore Roosevelt Medora Foundation. I ask for your support of SB 1018 for the Department of Commerce funding for tourism in total, in particular the \$7 million one-time funding provision included in the bill for tourism marketing.
