*When gasoline fuel that is blended with fifteen percent ethanol and biodiesel or renewable diesel is available, compatible, and results in a cost savings, the department of transportation shall use these fuels for all department and state fleet vehicles. State fleet vehicles refueling at non-state fuel sites should also use these fuels when available.*

or

*It is the intent of the 67<sup>th</sup> Legislative Assembly that the department of transportation use gasoline fuel with fifteen percent ethanol and the highest compatible percentage of biodiesel or renewable diesel for all department and state fleet vehicles when these products are available and result in a cost savings. State fleet vehicles refueling at non-state fuel sites should also use renewable fuels when available.*

Or

I think Rep. Kempenich wants something along these lines:

*The department of transportation shall use fuel that is blended with up to fifteen percent ethanol, and biodiesel or renewable diesel for all department vehicles when the fuels are compatible, unless these fuels are not available or are not economically feasible to purchase. This section does not apply to a state fleet vehicle refueling at a not-state fuel site.*

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2012

Page 1, line 3, after the first semicolon insert "to create and enact a new section to chapter 24-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to vehicle fuel requirements:

Page 3, after line 21, insert:

"SECTION 8. A new section to chapter 24-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

**Vehicle fuel requirements.**

The department of transportation shall use fuel that is blended with fifteen percent ethanol, and biodiesel or renewable diesel for all department vehicles, unless such fuels are not available or are not economically feasible to purchase. This section shall not apply to a state fleet vehicle refueling at a non-state fuel site."
