Working with survivors of brain injury is one of the most rewarding areas in my field. Their lives have significantly and unexpectedly changed, which requires me to create a plan of care to best meet their daily functional needs. This journey is very challenging for most and it is my pleasure to walk with them, encourage them, and educate them as they strive to reach therapeutic and functional goals.

The NDBIN is extremely valuable to us as providers, as well as survivors and families. This network places great emphasis on educating about brain injury by providing valuable resources for education and awareness, as well as hosting continuing education opportunities to stay updated on the current research to best serve our patients.
