SECTION 13. PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING GRANTS.
Subdivision 2 of section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$4,672,536 from the general fund for permanent supportive housing grants. SECTION 15. REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT SERVICES. Subdivision 2 of section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$6,069,408 of federal funds for the refugee resettlement program. The department of human services shall work with the federal partners to explore adding more resettlement locations to the state with a goal of resettling 25% of refugees outside of the existing resettlement locations.

"SECTION 32. REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT - STATEWIDE ACUTE PSYCHIATRIC AND RESIDENTIAL CARE NEEDS. During the 2021-22 interim, the department of human services, with the assistance of the state hospital's governing body, stakeholders, members of the legislative assembly, and consultants, shall review the acute psychiatric and residential needs of the state and prepare a report. The report must include a fifty-year plan for acute psychiatric and residential care in the state that includes options to contract with private care facilities to provide services in at least the four largest cities in the state and options to replace the existing state hospital facility with a new sixteen-bed treatment campus focused on forensic psychiatric evaluation and treatment. Before October 1, 2022, the department of human services shall present the report to the legislative management. Subdivision 3 of section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$300,000 to develop architectural plans and for other planning costs for the construction of a new sixteen-bed state hospital treatment campus. The department of human services shall seek Medicaid plan amendments or Medicaid waivers to allow federal funding reimbursement for services provided in institutions for mental diseases to Medicaid beneficiaries between the ages of twenty-one and sixty-four."
