Testimony on SB 2196 House Education Committee March 9, 2021

Chairman Owens and members of the Committee, for the record, I am Nick Archuleta, and I am the president of North Dakota United. On behalf of our membership, I rise today to support SB 2196 and to urge a DO PASS recommendation for this important and innovative piece of legislation.

SB 2196 allows for the creation and certification of a competency framework for the students of North Dakota. Once the framework is in place, students who have demonstrated a mastery of course content can waive further unit instructional time.
