I am bringing this bill as a constituent request

I realize that some adjustments may need to be made. It may be wise to increase the interest that the county charges so that someone look at the county as a source for a cheap loan. Perhaps there should be a review process where they need to justify why they need to from 2 years up to the 5 years.

People coming after me will say. We always try to work with people when they have difficulties. IF that is true I would argue that this bill shouldn't be a problem.

2 years is a short time. Allowing 5 years could make a difference between staying in your home or being driven out.
