Page 1, line 2, after "marijuana" insert "and the duty of the governor to enter agreements relating to marijuana businesses"

Page 9, after line 2, insert:

"SECTION 7. A new section to chapter 54-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Agreement for coordination and enforcement - Marijuana-related businesses.

- The governor may enter an agreement with the governing body of an Indian tribe recognized by the United States department of the interior and located in this state for the purpose of cross-jurisdictional coordination and enforcement of marijuana-related businesses licensed under chapters 19-24.1 and 19-24.3 to conduct business on tribal trust land by the governing body of the Indian tribe.
- 2. An agreement under this section may:
 - a. Provide for the cross-jurisdictional coordination and enforcement of marijuana compassion centers, dispensaries, manufacturing facilities, and marijuana testing laboratories licensed by the governing body of the Indian tribe.
 - <u>b.</u> Require the governing body of the Indian tribe to establish the same or similar requirements on marijuana compassion centers, dispensaries, manufacturing facilities, and marijuana testing laboratories consistent with chapters 19-24.1 and 19-24.3.
 - <u>c.</u> Ensure enforceable public health and safety standards and include a system to regulate and track the production, processing, and dispensing of marijuana for marijuana compassion centers, dispensaries, manufacturing facilities, and marijuana testing laboratories licensed by the governing body of the Indian tribe.
 - d. Authorize an agency of this state to assist in the implementation and enforcement of the terms of the agreement."
