RE: HB 1140 - Contingent Fee Arrangements

Today, I am appearing in my role as the Secretary for the Emergency Commission, of which I am also a member. N.D.C.C. § 54-16-01.

This bill is requesting an amendment to N.D.C.C. § 43-12-08.1. This section of law was adopted by the 1999 Legislative Assembly (1999 Session Laws, Chapter 453, SB 2047)

Since the enactment of this law 22 years ago, three requests seeking approval for a contingent fee arrangement have been submitted to the Emergency Commission. All three were from the Retirement and Investment Office.

Because of the confidential legal aspects of the requests, it is the only time the Emergency Commission has met in Executive Session; June 20, 2016, June 17, 2019, and May 12, 2020.

When the last request was considered in 2020 by the Emergency Commission, members questioned the relatively low threshold of \$150,000. It was suggested that the 2021 Legislative Assembly be asked to raise the threshold to one million dollars.

Because this section of law pertains to the Attorney General's authority, I contacted him. He agreed, that while the law should remain in place, he supports increasing the threshold to one million dollars.

I request your favorable consideration for a Do Pass recommendation.
