8	<u>1.</u>	Notwithstanding any other law or any provision in a governor's proclamation and
9		depending on availability, a disabled veteran, as defined in section 20.1-01-02, who is
10		a resident is entitled tomay purchase a disabled veteran white-tailed deer license
11		authorizing the disabled veteran to hunt, kill, take, and attempt to take any white-tailed
12		deer during the five days preceding the youth deer hunting season and during the
13		deer gun season. The director shall make one hundred disabled veteran white-tailed
14		deer licenses available each year.
15	2.	Each disabled veteran white-tailed deer license must be limited to one deer hunting
16		unit and may not permit hunting on any wildlife refuge or other public land. The
17		director shall identify the five deer hunting units with the lowest selection rates for deer
18		hunting licenses. Disabled veteran white-tailed deer licenses may not be used in those

20	3.	An individual who obtains a disabled veteran white-tailed deer license may not apply
