Chairman Luick and members of the Senate Agriculture Committee, I am Shaun Quissell, Grain and Livestock Licensing Division director here on behalf of Agriculture Commissioner Doug Goehring here in support of Senate Bill 2054.

Senate Bill 2054 is simply a bill to repeal the wool dealers license. North Dakota Department of Agriculture currently only licenses one wool dealer in the state at a license fee of ten dollars. There has yet to be a complaint brought against a wool dealer for payment of wool. We find it is no longer necessary to require a license and wish to repeal the law.
