Ag Development Center

There is \$20 million reserved in the General Fund from 2019-21. The \$50 million plus another 6.0 million along with the \$20 million equals a \$76 million dollar project. It includes the Meat Lab, Crop Commodities Lab, Northern Crops Institute and the Trade Office.
