Chairman and members of the committee – I am Dionne Haynes, a North Dakota resident and mother of two. I am submitting this testimony in support of House Bill 1510.

Vaccinations are a personal medical decision. People have various reasons as to why they choose to receive the medical procedure or to not subject themselves to such procedure.
