Mr. Wolf,

I have been listening to the Senate Transportation Committee and I heard members of the committee discussing the concern with the current wording of 39-29-09 subsection 9 relating to helmets for operators and riders 17 and younger. There is no requirement for any individual to wear a helmet while they are operating on private property. This is covered in the first sentence of 39-29-09 subsection 1 which states "An individual **may not operate an off-highway vehicle on the roadway, shoulder, or inside bank or slope of any road, street, or highway except as provided in this CHAPTER.**" Since the word "Chapter" is in this sentence it means that the wearing of a helmet is only required on the areas listed within the sentence. The sentence does not include private property so the helmet law under 39-39-09 (9) does not apply to private property. I hope this information is beneficial to the committee.

Would you be able to pass this along to Chairman Clemens?
