13		construction portions of the improvement. The agency construction manager shall					
14		evaluate the bids and award the subcontract to the lowest responsible bidder. The					
15		governing body may influence the selection of the subcontractors, but only insofar as					
16		the governing body's past experience with a subcontractor or a current legal dispute					
17		with a subcontractor.					
18	2.	A construction manager at-risk selected for a public improvement shall publicly					
19		advertise pursuant to section 48-01.2-04 and publicly open bids pursuant to section					
20		48-01.2-07 from subcontractors for the work items the construction manager at-risk					
21		chooses not to performnecessary to complete the general construction portions of the					
22		improvement. A construction manager at-risk must submit a bid for any work item					
23		necessary to complete the general construction portions of the improvement the					
24		construction manager at-risk chooses to perform pursuant to this section. The					
25		construction manager at-risk <del>then</del> shall evaluate the bids and <del>determine which is the</del>					
26		most responsibleaward the subcontract to the lowest responsible bidder. The

8		f <del>.</del>	<u>(6)</u>	Related experience on similar projects.			
9		<del>g.</del>	(7)	Recent and current work for the agency.			
10			<u>(8)</u>	Fees and expenses, which must be identified on a standard information			
11				submission form approved by the director of the office of management and			
12				budget and issued by the agency selection committee for the project.			
13		<u>b.</u>	Bas	ed upon these evaluations, the agency selection committee shall select the			
14			thre	e which, in its judgment, are most qualified, ranking the three in priority order.			
15			The	agency selection committee's report ranking the interviewed persons or firms			
16			mus	t be in writing and must include data substantiating its determinations. This			
17			data	a must be available to the public upon written request.
