1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-60 of the North Dakota

- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of the office of apprenticeship within the division of
- 3 workforce development of the department of commerce; and to amend and reenact section
- 4 54-60-17 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the division of workforce development;
- 5 to provide an appropriation; and to provide a report.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 7 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-60 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 8 and enacted as follows:
- 9 Office of apprenticeship Duties.
- 10 <u>1.</u> <u>There is created an office of apprenticeship within the division of workforce</u>
- 11 <u>development of the department.</u>
- Employees of the office of apprenticeship shall report to the director of the division of
 workforce development.
- 14 <u>3.</u> <u>The director of the division of workforce development may appoint an office supervisor</u>
- 15 to oversee the office. If the director of the division of workforce development appoints
- 16 <u>an office supervisor, all employees shall report to the office supervisor and the office</u>
- 17 <u>supervisor shall report to the director of the division of workforce development.</u>
- 18 <u>4.</u> <u>The office of apprenticeship:</u>
- 19a.Shall assist, coordinate, and collaborate with the state director from the office of20apprenticeship of the United States department of labor to administer the federal21apprenticeship system within the state.
- 22b.Shall develop and implement a statewide strategy to support the state director23from the office of apprenticeship of the United States department of labor to

1		maintain and manage existing apprenticeship programs and develop and expand
2		newly created apprenticeship programs in the state.
3	<u>C.</u>	Shall develop a pilot program to support a business operating or seeking to
4		create an apprenticeship program under the federal apprenticeship system.
5	<u>d.</u>	May contract with other state agencies to develop and administer programs to
6		assist the state director from the office of apprenticeship of the United States
7		department of labor in promoting entrance in the federal apprenticeship system.
8	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 54-60-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is	
9	amended and reenacted as follows:	
10	54-60-17. Division of workforce development - Internships, apprenticeships, and work	
11	experience opportunities.	
12	The division of workforce development shall administer a program to increase use of	
13	internships, apprenticeships, and work experience opportunities for higher education students,	
14	high school students enrolled in grade eleven or twelve, and educators. To increase	
15	apprenticeship in the state, the division shall utilize and collaborate with the office of	
16	apprenticeship. The primary focus of this program must be higher education internships in	
17	target industries. This program shall provide services to employers, communities, and business	
18	organizations to increase internship, apprenticeship, and work experience opportunities. The	
19	department shall maintain records of the number of internship, apprenticeship, and work	
20	experience opportunities subsidized within each funding recipient.	
21	SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE - OFFICE OF	
22	APPRENTICESHIP - FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS - REPORT TO THE	
23	SEVENTIET	H LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
24	general fund	in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$650,000, or so much
25	of the sum as	s may be necessary, to the department of commerce for the purpose of providing
26	salaries and benefits for the office of apprenticeship staff, for the biennium beginning July 1,	
27	2025, and ending June 30, 2027. The department of commerce is authorized three full-time	
28	equivalent positions to administer the office of apprenticeship. The department of commerce	
29	shall report to the seventieth legislative assembly regarding the number of apprentices and	
30	employers assisted through the office of apprenticeship and the number of new apprenticeship	
31	programs cre	eated during the 2025-27 biennium.
