1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the highway patrol;

2 and to provide for a transfer.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 7 other income, to the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the highway 8 patrol, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025, as follows: 9 Adjustments or 10 Base Level Enhancements Appropriation 11 Highway patrol \$62,113,414 <u>\$11,715,136</u> <u>\$73,828,550</u>

16 SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO

17 SIXTY-NINTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding

18 items approved by the sixty-seventh legislative assembly for the 2021-23 biennium and the

19 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

12 The 2023-25 biennium one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget 13 for the 2025-27 biennium. The highway patrol shall report to the appropriations committees of

14 the sixty-ninth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium

15 beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.

16 SECTION 3. ESTIMATED INCOME - TRANSFER - HIGHWAY TAX DISTRIBUTION FUND.

The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$11,575,949, or so
much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state highway tax distribution fund which may
be transferred at the direction of the superintendent of the highway patrol for defraying the
expenses of the highway patrol during the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending
June 30, 2025.

22 SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - MOTOR CARRIER ELECTRONIC PERMIT

23 **TRANSACTION FUND.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes

24 \$1,648,955 from the motor carrier electronic permit transaction fund for defraying various

expenses associated with the issuance of permits and other nonenforcement motor carrier andadministrative activities.

27 SECTION 5. TRANSFER - MOTOR CARRIER ELECTRONIC PERMIT FUND TO NORTH

28 **DAKOTA HIGHWAY PATROLMEN'S RETIREMENT FUND.** The office of management and

29 budget shall transfer the sum of \$2,000,000 from the motor carrier electronic permit fund to the

30 North Dakota highway patrolmen's retirement fund for the purpose of reducing the unfunded

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- 1 liability of the North Dakota highway patrolmen's retirement plan during the biennium beginning
- 2 July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.

3 SECTION 6. PAYMENTS TO HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS. Each patrol officer of the 4 state highway patrol is entitled to receive from funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act an 5 amount not to exceed \$200 per month for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending 6 June 30, 2025. The payments are in lieu of reimbursement for meals and other expenses, 7 except lodging, while in travel status within the state of North Dakota or while at the patrol 8 officers' respective home stations. The amounts must be paid at the time and in the same 9 manner as salaries are paid to members of the highway patrol and may be paid without the 10 presentation of receipts or other memorandums.
