## **ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1024**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of
- 2 environmental quality; and to amend and reenact sections 23.1-10-02 and 23.1-10-05 of the
- 3 North Dakota Century Code, relating to the environmental quality restoration fund and revenue
- 4 to the fund and to provide for an exemption.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the department of environmental quality for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the department of environmental quality, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025, as follows:

4	The	There is established an environmental quality restoration fund into which the funds			
5	recovere	recovered in this chapter may be deposited. The fund is to be administered by the department

7	assessment, removal, corrective action, or monitoring as determined on a case-by-case basis.				
8	All moneys placed in the fund under this section and section 23.1-10-05 are appropriated to the				
9	department on a continuing basis. If, on the first day of July in any year, the amount of				
0	uncommitted or unrestricted money in the environmental quality restoration fund is more than				
11	five million dollars, the amount in excess of five million dollars must be transferred to the				
2	general fund.				
3	SEC	SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 23.1-10-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
4	amended and reenacted as follows:				
5	23.1-10-05. Revenue to the fund.				
6	Revenue from the following sources must be deposited in the state treasury and credited to

22		stipulation, or settlement. This section does not limit the department's ability to agree			
23		to a supplemental environmental project as part of a settlement.

30	SEC	CTION 7. EXEMPTION - LABORATORY INFORMATION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.			

The sum of \$1,000,000, appropriated from the general fund for the laboratory information

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- 1 management system in section 1 of chapter 52 of the 2021 Session Laws, is not subject to the
- 2 provisions of section 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended funds from this appropriation are available for
- 3 the laboratory information management system during the biennium beginning July 1, 2023,
- 4 and ending June 30, 2025.
