

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT  
with House Amendments  
ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2024**

Appropriations Committee

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the ethics  
2 commission; and to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the ethics commission for the purpose of defraying the  
7 expenses of the ethics commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending  
8 June 30, 2025, as follows:

14 **SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO SIXTY-**  
15 **NINTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding items  
16 included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

21 The 2023-25 biennium one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget  
22 for the 2025-27 biennium. The ethics commission shall report to the appropriations committees  
23 of the sixty-ninth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium  
24 beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.

1       **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** The sum of \$97,000 for attorney fees and office relocation  
2 costs included in the ethics commission line item in section 1 of this Act is declared to be an  
3 emergency measure.
