- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study relating to criminal history
- 2 record checks; and to provide an appropriation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

| 4 | SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD |
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| 5 | CHECK PROCESS. During the 2023-24 interim, the legislative management shall consider |
| 6 | studying the statewide criminal history record check process. The study may include a |
| 7 | comparison between the statewide and nationwide criminal history record check standards, a |
| 8 | review of the average processing time of a requested criminal history record check, and an |

- 9 evaluation of methods to improve efficiency and processing times of the statewide criminal
- 10 history record check process. The legislative management shall report its findings and
- 11 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 12 the sixty-ninth legislative assembly.
- 13 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES -
- 14 CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECKS. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 15 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$300,000, or so much
- of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of health and human services for the
- 17 purpose of salary and wages for personnel to process fingerprints and complete required
- 18 criminal history record checks and for the purchase of two fingerprint scanners, for the biennium
- beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025. The department is authorized two full-time
- 20 equivalent positions to process fingerprints for criminal history record checks.
