- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for an appropriation to the department of health and human
- 2 services for the development of a pregnancy and parenting resource website; and to declare an
- 3 emergency.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES -
- 6 PREGNANCY AND PARENTING RESOURCE WEBSITE ONE-TIME FUNDING. There is
- 7 appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise
- 8 appropriated, the sum of \$100,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the
- 9 department of health and human services for the purpose of developing and maintaining a state
- 10 internet website that provides information and links to social services, financial assistance,
- 11 adoption services, pregnancy and parenting information, planning guidance, care centers and
- 12 agencies, and other available public and private resources for expectant families and new
- 13 parents, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act, and ending June 30, 2025.
- 14 The department shall contract with a third party for the development of the website. The
- department shall promote and market the website by publishing easily comprehensible printed
- 16 materials and placing visible billboards in high-traffic areas to inform expectant families and new
- parents about the website. The website must be operational by August 1, 2023, and have the
- domain name life.nd.org or a similar domain name if the specified domain name is not available.
- 19 The website must be distinct from the department's government website and the department
- shall place a clear and conspicuous link to the website on the department's government
- 21 website. The funding provided in this section is considered a one-time funding item.
- **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
