- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the attorney general for a law enforcement
- 2 resiliency grant program.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION ATTORNEY GENERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 5 **RESILIENCY GRANT PROGRAM.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund
- 6 in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$400,000, or so much of the sum
- 7 as may be necessary, to the attorney general for the purpose of providing a law enforcement
- 8 resiliency program grant to a local children's advocacy center, for the biennium beginning
- 9 July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025. Funding provided under this Act must be used to
- defray administrative, therapeutic, training, and outreach-related costs of providing mental
- 11 health and wellness support services to current and retired correctional and law enforcement
- 12 personnel. The attorney general shall establish guidelines to award funding under this section.
