- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the state historical society for the study and
- 2 design of a monument recognizing native Americans killed at Whitestone Hill State Historic Site.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY WHITESTONE HILL
- 5 NATIVE MEMORIAL ONE-TIME FUNDING. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 6 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$250,000, or so much
- 7 of the sum as may be necessary, to the state historical society for the purpose of conducting a
- 8 study and designing a monument in recognition of the native Americans killed at Whitestone Hill
- 9 State Historic Site, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025. The
- 10 funding provided in this section is considered a one-time funding item.
