- A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 43-03-03 and, 43-03-04, and subsections 4

  and 5 of section 43-03-13 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to membership of the state board of architecture and landscape architecture; and to provide for application.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-03-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 43-03-03. State board of architecture and landscape architecture Members Term of office How vacancies filled.
    - 1. The state board of architecture and landscape architecture consists of threefive members appointed by the governor for terms of six years each with their terms of office staggered so arranged that no more than one term and only one expires on March fourteenth of each odd-numbered year.
    - 2. The board is composed of twothree architects, two landscape architects, and including up to one layperson landscape architect.
    - a. To qualify for appointment, each architect member must have at least five years'
      experience in active practice as a principal architect in the state.
      - b. To qualify for appointment, each landscape architect member must have at least five years' experience in active practice as a principal landscape architect in the state.
      - c. To qualify for appointment, the layperson member may not be associated with the design, construction, or related consulting industries.
      - 3. Each member of the board shall qualify by taking the oath of office required of civil officers and shall hold office until that member's successor is appointed and qualified,

3	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 43-03-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
4	amended and reenacted as follows:
5	43-03-04. Qualifications of members of board - Removal of members.
6	Each member of the board must be a resident of this state who is an architect or landscape
7	architect and who has been a resident of and in active practice in this state as an architect for
8	not less than five years before appointment. The governor may remove any member of the
9	board for inefficiency or neglect of duty.
10	SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 43-03-13 of the North Dakota Century
11	Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	4. In the case of an architect, must holdeither:
13	a. Hold a professional degree in architecture from an accredited school of
14	architecture and must have the required practical experience, as established by
15	the board; <u>or</u>
16	b. Provide evidence of education and experience that is substantially equivalent to a
17	professional degree and practical experience, as established by the board;
18	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Subsection 5 of section 43-03-13 of the North Dakota Century
19	Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
20	5. In the case of a landscape architect, must hold <u>aeither:</u>
21	a. A professional degree in landscape architecture from an accredited school of
22	landscape architecture and must have the required practical experience, as
23	established by the board; and or
24	b. Provide evidence of education and experience that is substantially equivalent to a
25	professional degree and practical experience, as established by the board; and
26	<b>SECTION 5. APPLICATION.</b> Notwithstanding section 43-03-03, to stagger terms, the initial
