1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a study of youth services for children impacted or potentially
2 impacted by human trafficking; and to provide for a legislative management report.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES - STANDARD**
5 **FRAMEWORK OF SERVICES FOR CHILD VICTIMS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING - REPORT**
6 **TO LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT.**

- 7 1. During the 2023-24 interim, the department of health and human services shall study
8 and implement, in collaboration with other stakeholders, a standard framework for
9 youth services for children impacted or potentially impacted by human trafficking,
10 which includes residential treatment.
- 11 2. The department of health and human services shall collaborate with other
12 stakeholders, including the child and family services section of the department of
13 health and human services, the office of the attorney general, and the human
14 trafficking task force.
- 15 3. Before January 2, 2024, the department of health and human services shall report its
16 findings and recommendations to the legislative management.
