

**SECOND ENGROSSMENT  
with Conference Committee Amendments  
REENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2107**

1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study relating to statutory provisions  
2 that prohibit certain individuals from possessing a firearm.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - FIREARM POSSESSION.** During  
5 the 2023-24 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying those provisions of the  
6 North Dakota Century Code which prohibit certain individuals from possessing a firearm. The  
7 study may include an examination of the state's firearm and weapon possession prohibitions as  
8 compared to the federal regulations. The study must include an examination of whether the  
9 category of individuals prohibited from possessing a firearm by statute should be maintained in  
10 its current form, narrowed, or expanded. The study must include input from the attorney  
11 general, the supreme court, the North Dakota association of counties, the North Dakota league  
12 of cities, the North Dakota state's attorneys' association, the North Dakota association of  
13 criminal defense lawyers, the North Dakota peace officers association, and the national rifle  
14 association. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations,  
15 together with any legislation necessary to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-ninth  
16 legislative assembly.
