# 6 <u>Wild and scenic rivers.</u>

- Before a political subdivision engages in meetings with federal agencies to have any
   waterbody in the state designated a wild, scenic, or recreational river under the Wild
   and Scenic Rivers Act [16 U.S.C. 1271, et seq.] the political subdivision must notify
   the:
- 11 <u>a.</u> <u>Director of the department of water resources;</u>
- 12 b. Director of the department of environmental quality;
- 13 <u>c.</u> <u>Director of game and fish;</u>
  - d. Director of parks and recreation;
- e. <u>The water Water resource board of any water resource district that would be</u>
  impacted;
  - f. Director of the department of land trust lands;
  - g. Director of the department of mineral resources;
  - h. <u>The countyCounty commission of any county impacted;</u>
    - i. The legislators Legislators of any district impacted; and
    - j. <u>The grazing</u>Grazing associations impacted; and
- 22 k. Public service commission.
- 2. Any written communications between the political subdivision and federal agencies
   24 regarding such designation must be copied to the list in subsection 1.

- 1 <u>3.</u> <u>The county commission shall hold a public hearing regarding the potential designation.</u>
- 2 <u>4.</u> <u>The governor and the county commission of any county impacted must express</u>
- 3 written support before the state or a federal agency designates a wild, scenic, or
- 4 recreational river under the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act.
