**3 - Bill and Fiscal Impact Summary**

SB 2201 reduces the maximum qualifying patient application fee, reduces fee amount for additional plants, requires the Department to pay the costs of criminal history record checks, modifies fee language, and includes a possible study of the administrative costs of certifying a compassion center.

Section 2 and Section 4 require the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) to pay the costs of criminal history record checks. Section 5 reduces the fee amount paid by manufacturing facilities for additional plants over 1,000 (fee paid every two years). The reduction of the qualifying patient application fee to \$25 in Section 1 has no fiscal impact as the fee is \$25 as established in administrative rule.

The Department projects the impact of reducing fees will reduce revenue by \$45,000 in the 23-25 biennium and the 25-27 biennium.
