Hello Senator Rust,

I apologize for not attending the last Senate Appropriations hearing when the highway patrol's budget was finalized in committee. Senator Dever asked a question related to \$3 million for remodeling the Law Enforcement Training Academy (LETA), and an amendment was added on the Senate floor to carry over some of that funding.

There are two additional carry-over items that were recently brought to my attention following that floor vote. I will share these with Representative Mock as well because he carried the highway patrol's budget bill on the House side.

- Statewide Interoperable Radio Network (SIRN) Project
  - The highway patrol was appropriated \$2,612,000 in one-time funding from the State Fiscal Recovery Fund for SIRN.
  - Most of the equipment has been purchased and received, but there are some items and installation costs that will not be completed this biennium.
  - o The highway patrol is requesting that \$628,750 be carried over into the 2023-25 biennium.
    - \$165,750 for vehicle installations
    - \$28,000 for command center radio and installation
    - \$110,000 for initializing and programming costs (NDIT, vendors)
    - \$120,000 for office base stations
    - \$40,000 for miscellaneous equipment and supplies
    - \$165,000 for 10 additional sworn officers
- LETA SiteLogIQ Repairs
  - The highway patrol was appropriated \$246,000 in ARPA funding for two projects:
    - Energy management (building automation) \$88,000
    - Pneumatic controls \$158,000

- o Both of these projects are being done in conjunction with the larger \$3 million remodel which may not be completed until the fall of 2023.
- The highway patrol is requesting that \$246,000 be carried over into the 2023-25 biennium.

I'm hoping these additions can be added to the bill during a future conference committee. I can share this information with legislative council and OMB as well. If you need any further information, please let me know!
