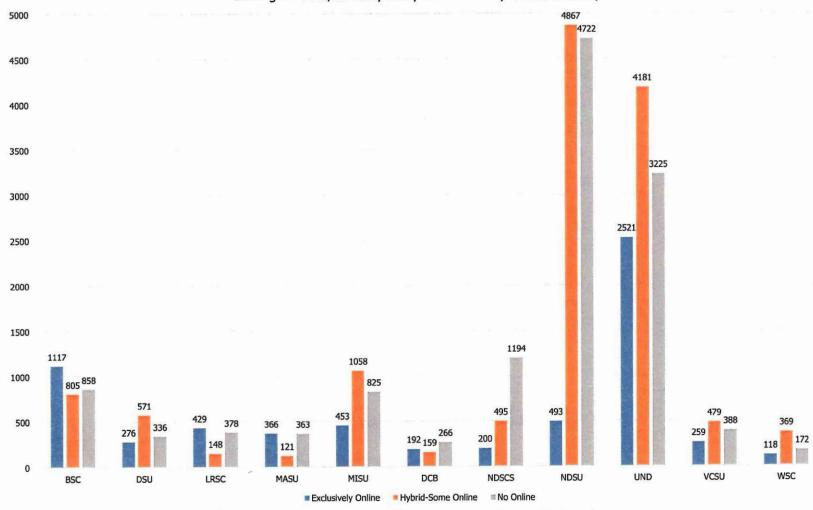

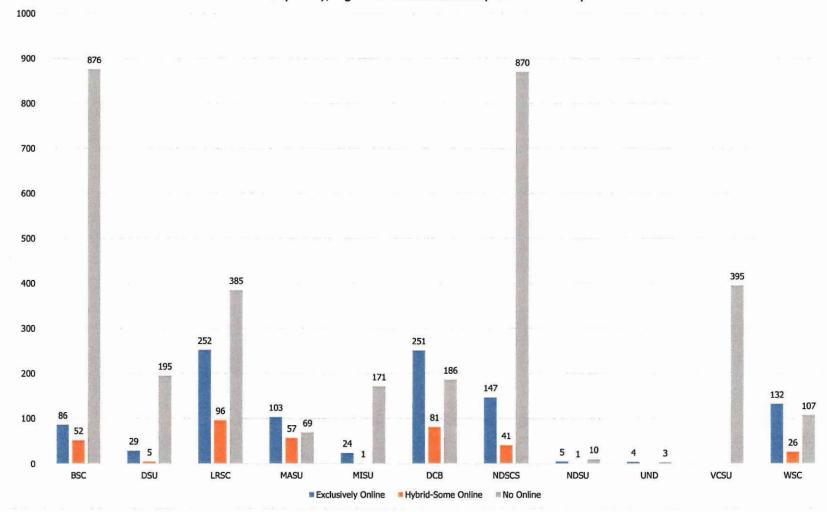
Undergraduates/No Early Entry Headcount by Online Delivery

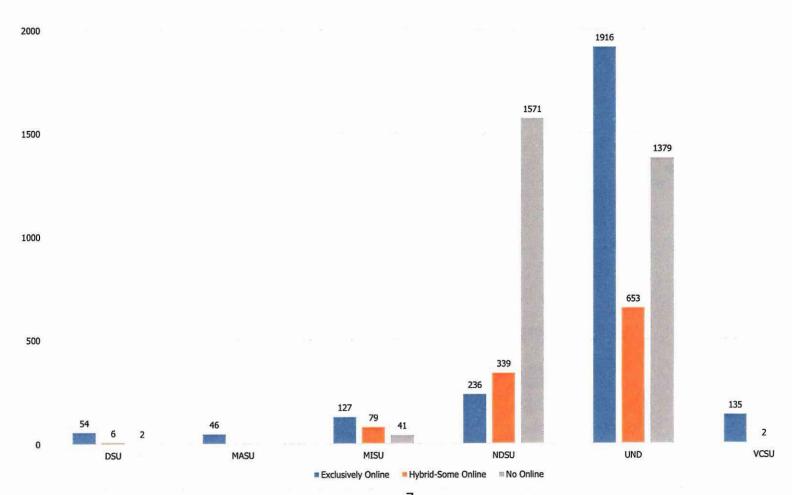
Early Entry/High School Headcount by Online Delivery

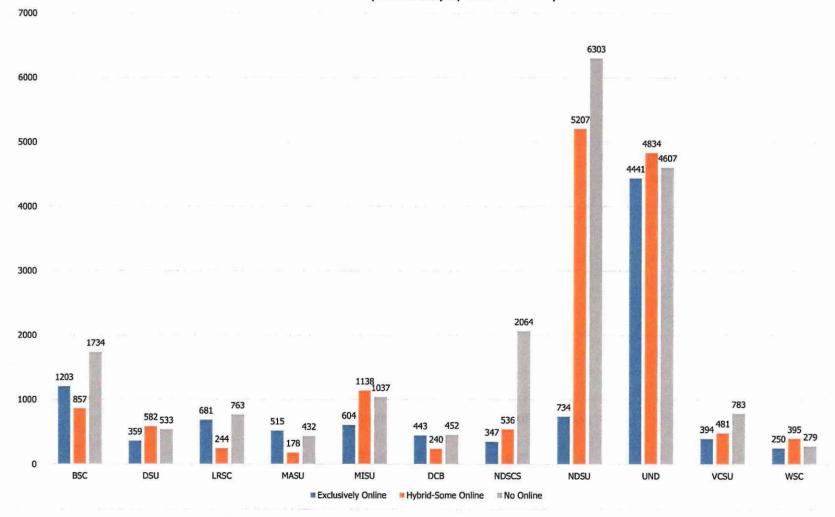


Graduate & Professional Headcount by Online Delivery





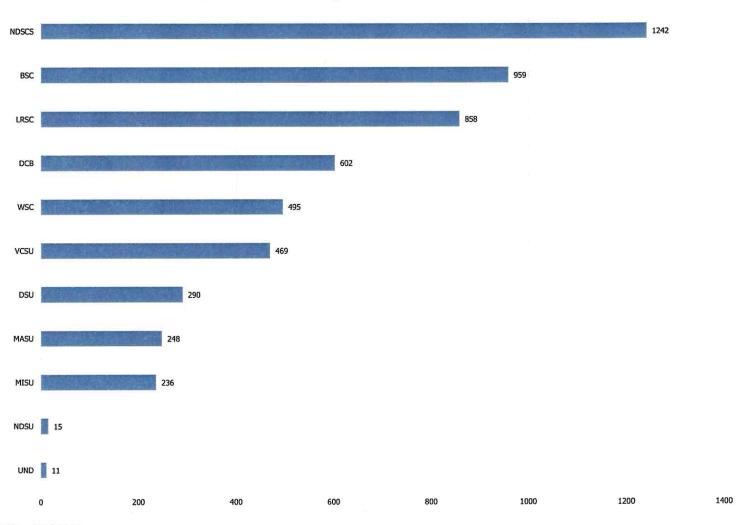
All Students (Headcount) by Online Delivery

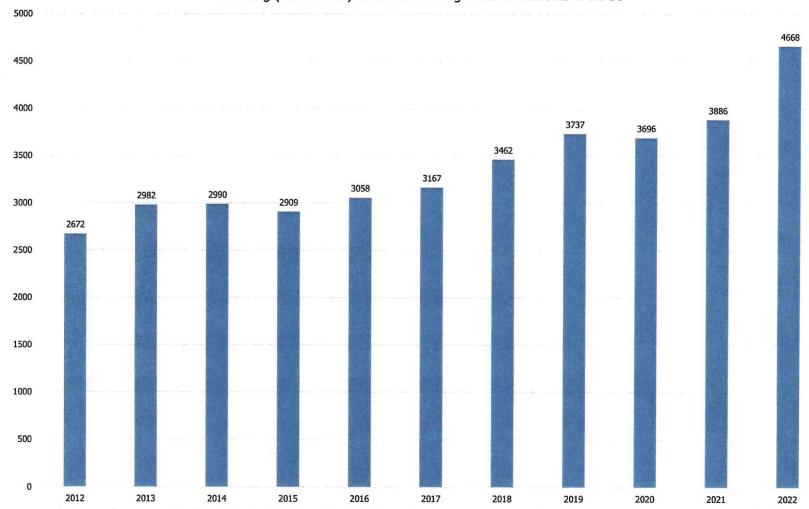


Unduplicated Headcount of High School Students - Academic Year 2021-22

Public Service

Public service includes activities established primarily to provide non-instructional services that are beneficial to individuals and groups external to the institution. There are four institutions that include public service expenditures, and are NDSU, UND, MiSU, and MaSU. Some examples of expenditures that fall under public service include NDSU Extension Centers, MiSU Center for Distance Education, MaSU Headstart program, UND Center for Innovation, UND Aerospace, UND Small Business Development, UND TRIO, and UND/SMHS Rural Health.

Institutions with Online Course Fees

There are 6 institutions charging distance education fees to students:

- NDSCS Distance Education Fee \$38.00 per credit, all other mandatory fees are charged to all students except the Student Activity Fee. The distance education fee is utilized for additional resources required to provide online courses, such as online class technologies (Yuja, Smarthinking, Respondus), personalized instructional design support, oversight requirements and certifications relating to State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements, online instructors.
- WSC Distance Education Fee \$33.68 per credit, all other mandatory fees are charged to all students. The distance education fee is utilized for IVN/video equipment, software licenses, Information Technologist salaries, early entry/dual credit employees, and Extended Learning Director salary.
- DCB Distance Education Fee \$39.66 per credit, all other mandatory fees are charged to all students. The distance education fee is used to support on-going distance education, course development and redesign, professional development for faculty, learning Management System (LMS), lecture capture storage (YUGA), blackboard Learn storage, SARA fees, NetTutor fees, and staffing needed to support the online learner.
- VCSU Distance Education fee \$45.89 per credit, online students also charged ConnectND, NDSA, and Technology fee, but not charged any other mandatory fees. The distance fee provides partial funding for the salary and benefit costs for the positions teaching, designing, and supporting distance courses. The fee also supports the design framework of VCSU distance courses.
- MaSU Delivery Fee \$37.57 per credit, all other mandatory fees are charged to all students (ConnectND, NDSA, Technology, Access [Distance fee amount less then Campus], Activity [Distance fee amount less then Campus]). The delivery fee is to pay for student and staff support for the online delivery format, instructional design and faculty related to online classes and offset associated technology associated the same.
- LRSC Distance Delivery Fee \$6.00 per credit. ConnectND, NDSA, and Technology Fees are charged to all students. Online Students are not charged Activity Fees or Facility Usage Fee. The distance delivery fee is used for software related to online courses.
- UND Same fees charged to all students
- BSC Same fees charged to all students
- NDSU Same fees charged to all students
- DSU Same fees charged to all students
- MiSU Same fees charged to all students
