\*ND Career Builders Skilled Workforce Scholarship and Loan Repayment program are continuing appropriation. As of January 8, 2023, it is anticipated the ND Career Builders Skilled Workforce Scholarship is anticipated to be fully expended before the 2023-25 biennium concludes and the ND Career Builders Skilled Workforce Loan Repayment program is anticipated to have \$852,593 remaining at the end of 2023-25.

### Introduced Bills related to Financial Aid Programs

- [HB1030](#) – provides clarification and adjustments to various financial aid programs.
- [HB1031](#)– Student Financial Aid Grant Assistance, increase student grants from \$1,100 to \$1,600 per semester, increases appropriation by \$12 million from \$23.9 million to \$35.9 million; Academic and Career and Technical Education Scholarship, increases appropriation by \$1 million, from \$16.2 million to \$17.2 million; and Dual Credit Tuition Scholarship, appropriates \$1.5 million from BND profits.
- [HB1032](#) – High Demand Certificate Programs, appropriation of \$1 million. *CDL + 1,000,000*
- [HB1240](#) – ND Career Builders - Adds final 2 years of teacher education program as eligible program for scholarship and allows public funds as match. \$2 million appropriation from legacy earnings. *Nursing Asst. \$1500 limit + 2,000,000*
- [HB1305](#) – Incorporates additional scholarship requirements in high school.
- [HB1382](#) – Adds eligibility for the Academic/CTE/ND scholarships for apprenticeship programs. Fiscal impact is \$399,000. *+ 399,000*

- NO • HB1451 – Increases the amount of the Academic/CTE/ND scholarship to \$10,000 maximum, \$1,250/sem. or \$833/qtr. Includes \$5.6 million general fund appropriation.
- + 1,000,000 • HB1470 – Back-to-College Grant for students aged 25 or older who have not received a first degree. Includes \$1 million general fund appropriation.
- + 3,000,000 • SB2033 – Creates teacher shortage loan forgiveness program administered by DPI. \$3 million general fund appropriation.
- SB2127 – Behavioral health student loan repayment program at DHHS. \$377,600 general fund + \$510,400 community health trust fund.
- + 10,000,000 • SB2197 – Re-energize ND scholarship for oil industry workers & dependents. \$10 million general fund.
- NOT HELD • SB2287 – Adds eligibility for registered nurses to receive loan repayment administered by DHHS. Includes a \$.5 million general fund appropriation.
- + 2,000,000 • SB 2270 – Student teacher grant. No appropriation/fiscal note. Administered by DPI.
- 33,400,000 • Challenge Grant.
