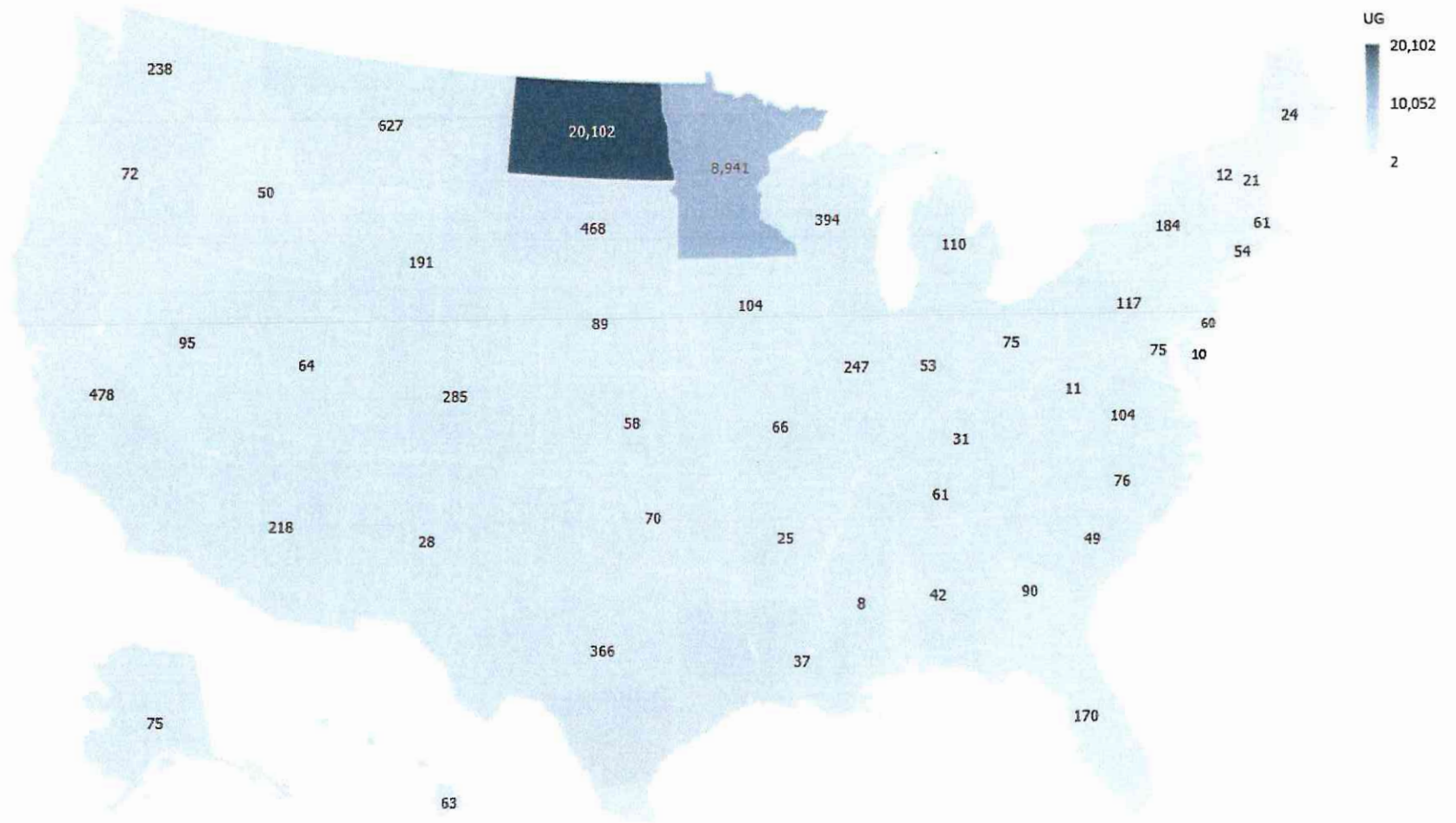

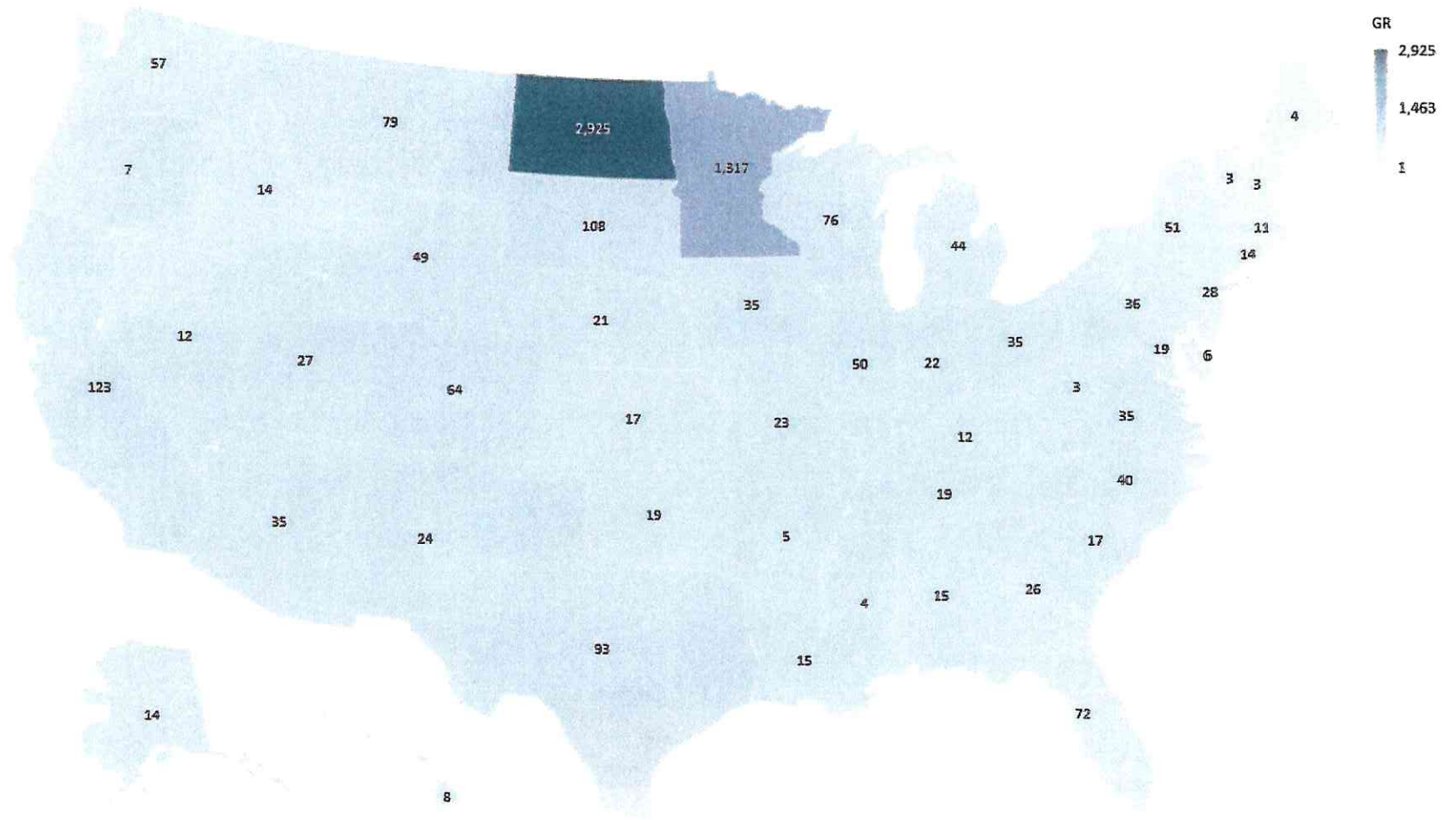

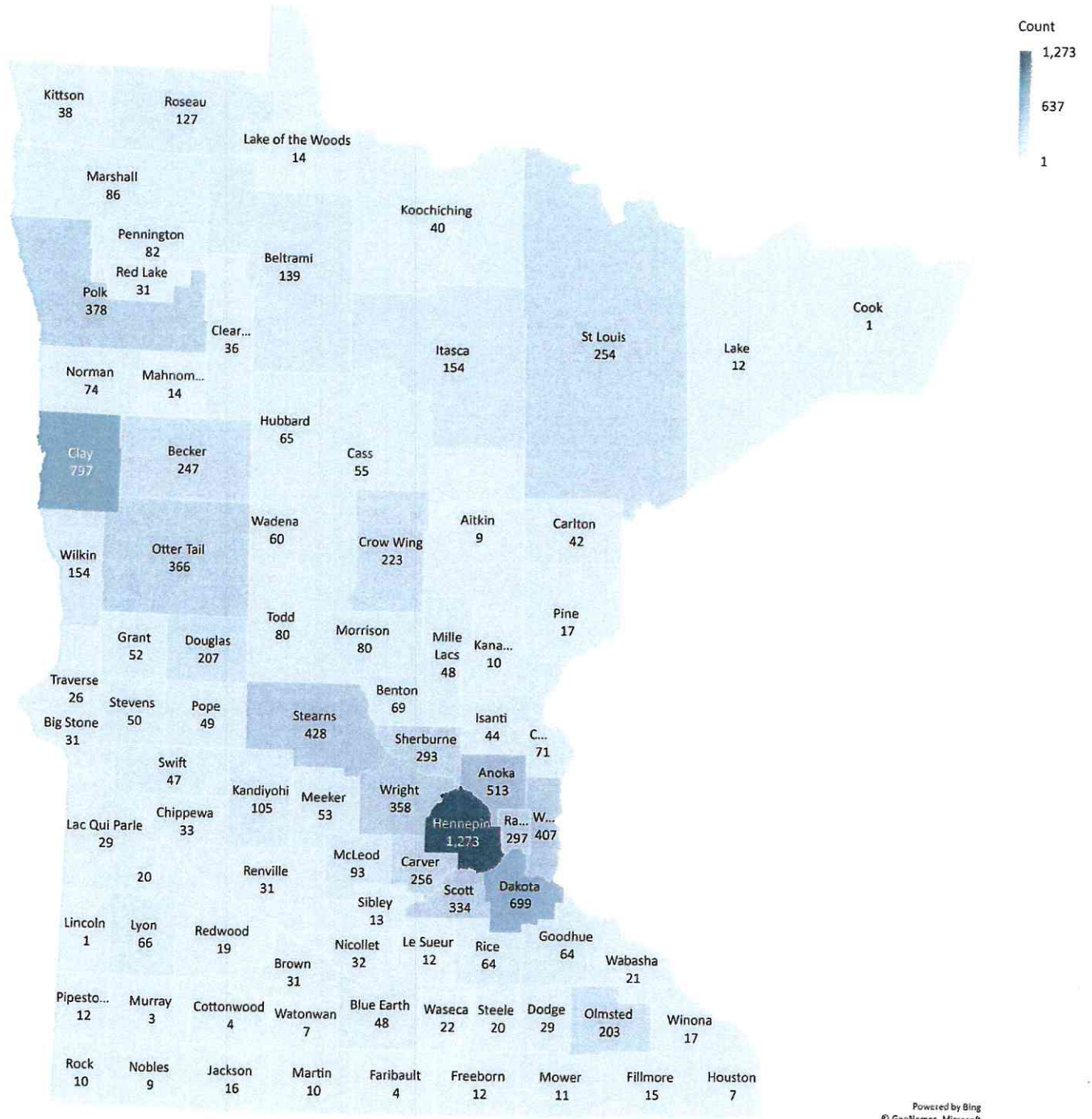


# A4: Graduate headcounts by state of origin
