




2023-25 Executive Recommendation

By Line Item




2023-25 Executive Recommendation By Funding Source



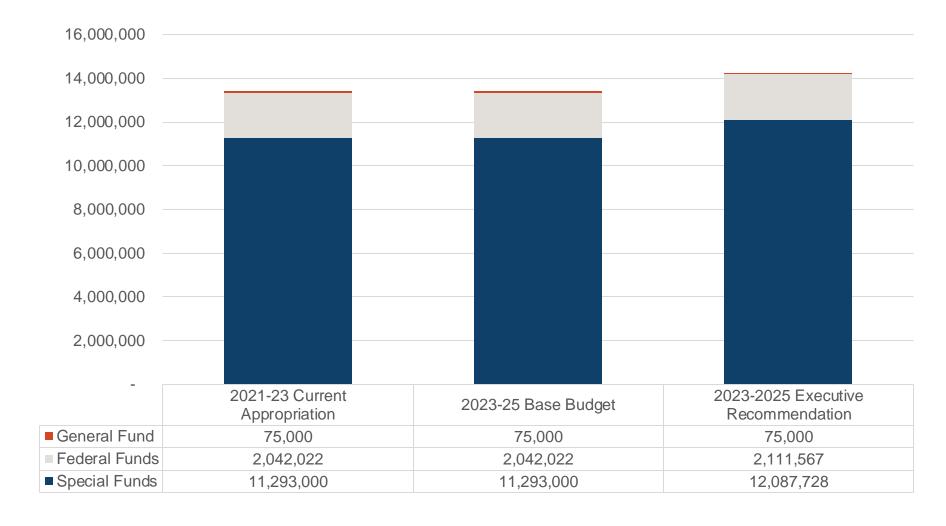

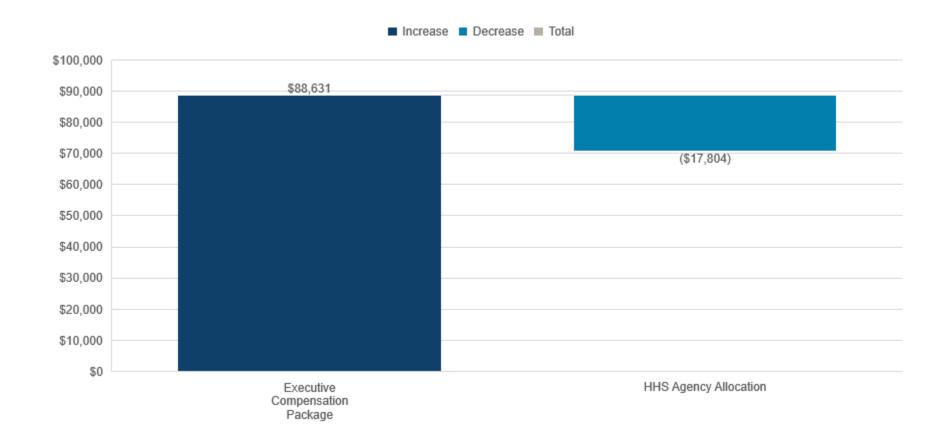
Overview of Budget Changes




Overview of Funding Changes



Major Salary & Wage Differences




Major Operating Differences






Major Grant Differences
